

ARUSAW YOUTH TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES



1. EVENT

- a. Tournament must be sanctioned through USA Wrestling and all participants will be USAW members
- b. ARYW will provide the TD with a link for the standard tournament flyer for posting on media accounts.
 - i. Tournament flyers will have contact information, weight classes, dates, times, address, and entry fees at a minimum
- c. Recommend split session competition
- d. Tournament director/head table clearly identified
- e. Double elimination/round robin as feasible
- f. Score clocks/monitors that are visible from both sides
- g. PA system available for announcing

2. FACILITY

- a. Provide ample space for mats and away from hazards
- b. Provide separation of competition area and spectators
- c. Minimum of 4 wrestling surfaces for multi-session opens, girls and novice events. Full mats with obvious taped lines if separated
 - i. Triple Crown (TC) events will have minimum of 6 full mat surfaces; surfaces can be split to make 8 surfaces.
 - ii. TC will have onsite or designated weigh-in locations
 - iii. TC awards will be purchased from ARYW
- d. Provide ample restroom and concessions for duration of event

3. PERSONNEL

- a. Minimum of 2 table workers per wrestling mat area
- b. Trainer/medical personnel ARE MANDATORY.
- c. Security to keep spectators away from mats
- d. Check-in monitor to verify USA Wrestling Coach's card

4. COMPUTER ACCESS

- a. Computer and internet connection per table at wrestling mat
- b. Computer and internet connection at head table
- c. Recommended separate connection for tournament from spectator access

5. VENDORS/CONCESSIONS

- a. Shall have the appropriate membership through USA Wrestling. Sponsor/Vendor Membership, or a Media Membership, or an Event Volunteer Membership
- b. Shall understand the scope, size, and duration of event
- c. Recommend healthy/nutritional options for competitors

6. OFFICIALS

- a. All efforts will be made to obtain USA Wrestling certified officials
- b. Officials will be assigned by surfaces, with the following schedule:
 - i. 2 mats = 3 officials
 - ii. 3 mats = 4 officials
 - iii. 4 mats = 5 officials
 - iv. 5 mats = 7 officials
 - v. 6 mats = 8 officials
 - vi. 7 mats = 9 officials
 - vii. 8 mats = 10 officials
 - viii. 9+ mats = Coordinate with Officials Director
- c. Head referee will be identified/introduced at coaches meeting
- d. New officials and training officials may be assigned at no charge or a reduced rate as coordinated with the TD and Officials Director.

7. SUPPLIES

- a. Each mat table will have cleaning supplies, paper towels, ankle bands etc
- b. Blood and vomit cleaning materials available
- c. Physical barriers to separate competition areas
- d. Restroom product replacements available
- e. Scale for challenges

8. MISCELLANEOUS

- a. \$1/wrestler entry fee paid to ARYW within one week of tournament
- b. Award podium recommended for presentation and photography
- c. Host will enforce crowd control and keep spectators away from mats
- 9. All ARYW host tournament directors and facilities will abide by these guidelines to their utmost capability or risk losing their ability to host a tournament. TC events MUST meet all requirements, or they will not be considered as a TC host.
- 10. Coach's bands will be issued at a ratio of 2 band for first 5 wrestler entries and 1 per every 5 additional entries. TD reserve the right to charge for additional coaches bands.
